### Academic Cycle

Students enroll in the academic introductory eleven Independent Study FEMA Emergency Management Institute courses. The subject matter of these courses ranges from mitigating threats and preparedness, including managing any size incidents, all hazard disasters, to climate change. Other ingredients include learning expeditions and field and tabletop exercises. Students will have continuing education credits, certificates, and transcripts from FEMA's Emergency Management Institutes upon completion. Students will also learn presentation strategies for pursuing an entry-level job or college.
